

On a cold weekend in mid January...

Fr. Gerard Monaghan, informed the parishioners of St. Margaret-Mary and St. Edith Stein that the office of the Archdiocese has approved the name "St. Faustina" to be the name of our newly formed parish.

Fr. Gerard informs that it will be a while yet until all the proper canonical procedures are completed to become this new entity. In the meantime, the new name should help us form our new identity and aid us in our quest to raise funds and to promote our new parish to others.

Soon we will be able to raise funds under the name of St. Faustina

Fund-Raising

How we receive our funds...

Brad Chippior reports that 95 families have pledged approximately \$225,000 to date. There were 15 one-time donations; 63 monthly pledges; 3 annual gifts and 5 other donations. (Tax receipts will will become available mid-February.)

Pink envelopes have been added to the pews to collect additional funds.



Did you know...

Based on our fund-raising and pledges so far, we are within \$70,000 of paying off the mortgage on the land in three years! A great community achievement!

Statistics from research conducted by The Dynamic Catholic Institute show that roughly 7 percent of Catholic parishioners are doing almost everything in their faith community and paying almost entirely for the maintenance and mission of the parish.


Expenses coming up in the short term -
